Life-Study of Matthew – Study Guide

Dear brothers and sisters,

We will continue this week's truth pursuit with Message 26 of the *Life-study of Matthew*, entitled The Continuation of the King's Ministry (2). This life-study covers Matt. 8:23-9:8. which addresses the authority of the King in three aspects: the authority over the winds and sea (8:23-27), the authority over the demons (vv.28-34), and the authority to forgive sins (9:1-8).

Here is an excerpt from this message followed by key verses for pray-reading and questions for your study:

The Lord's authority was manifested over the winds and the sea. This is not an ordinary authority; rather, it must be counted as an extraordinary authority...This authority is to deal with the negative things, the opposing environment instigated by the evil spirits, the demons, and the corrupting sins. Christ as the heavenly King has the full authority to deal with all of these, and all of these are subdued under His authority. This brings in the establishing of His heavenly kingdom on the earth...This bird's-eye view of this portion of the Word affords us a vivid portrait of who the heavenly King is. (Witness Lee, *Life-study of Matthews*, Living Stream Ministry, Anaheim, CA, msg. 26).

Key Verses for pray-reading: Matt. 8:26; 31-32; 9:6-7.

Questions:

1. What was the Lord's intention in permitting the demons to go into the hogs?
2. What was the purpose of the Lord Jesus exercising His God given authority in the cases mentioned in Matt 8:23-9:8?
3. What is the overall picture given in Matt.8:1-9:8 regarding who the heavenly King is?
