❖ Intercessory Prayers for North America

- **For the GTCA cities**
 - To fellowship, to blend, to give and to migrate in the oneness and one accord of the Body to gain typical Americans.

❖ For the Lord's move on the earth

- **UK & Ireland Blending Conference in Leeds, UK (this weekend, 26-27 August)**
711 are registered - 29 creche age, 76 children (4 to 12), 54 young people and 552 adults. With registration at the door the final number may exceed 800. Please pray that:
 - The Lord to strengthen our brother Ron for the release of the word.
 - The travel - that all the saints will be able to attend, despite the train strikes.
 - The blending and fellowship of all the saints and churches in the UK and Ireland.
 - The encouragement and supply of the church in Leeds.
- **European University Training, (8-13 September) Glasgow, Scotland**
 - Pray that the Lord will raise up many university students in Europe to pursue Him and gain Him for His Body.
- **Autumn Chinese-speaking conference in Paris (15-17 September)**
- **Gospel Trips in Germany, Switzerland, and Austria (8-22 October)**
 - The saints in the recovery are invited to join the campus labor at the beginning of the university year in Germany, Switzerland, and Austria. Please pray that the Lord will gain many students in these three countries as remaining fruit and for the spread of the Lord's testimony in these countries through the gospel trips.
- **The Church in London**
 - **Bower House & Lee Hall Construction Project Planning Permission**
 - Please pray for the enemy to be bound and the permission to construct be released. May the Lord rule over the council planning officers for the sake of His move.
- **Meeting hall for the Church in Paris**
 - This property is in Paris/Saclay, the most important growth area in greater Paris. This multi-functional property will provide a place for the saints to meet, blend, and perfect one another. (Please see the details in the announcement letter)
- **Meeting halls in Munich and Stuttgart, Germany, and in Malaga, Spain**
 - Please pray that the Lord will provide the needed finances through the Body.
 - The current need in Malaga is for 81,000 euros by the end of September to close the purchase and for an estimated 335,000 euros for remodeling.
- **Migration of burdened saints to six designated European cities**
 - Barcelona, Brussels, Dublin, Lisbon, Rome, and Zurich
- **The conflict in Ukraine**
 - The Lord will keep all the saints in the involved countries open to Him for His divine dispensing.
 - The Lord will meet the practical needs of the saints and preserve their tripartite being for His interests.
 - The brothers who are fighting in the war will be preserved in their tripartite being.
 - The Lord will comfort and sustain those who have lost loved ones in the war.
 - The enemy will be bound in his attack on the Lord's interests in Russia, Ukraine, and Europe.
